files of papers in this site, but PDF files of general articles can be done only by the member of the Society of

Powder Technology, Japan.

Submission

When submitting the manuscript, manuscripts must be prepared in accordance with this regulation and the guide

for authors. The complete set of manuscripts must be sent to the editorial office with e-mail attachment (e-mail:

kaishi@sptj.jp).

**Submission declaration** 

Submission of an article implies that the work described has not been published previously (except in the form

of an abstract or as part of a published lecture or academic thesis), that it is not under consideration for publication

elsewhere, that its publication is approved by all authors and tacitly or explicitly by the responsible authorities

where the work was carried out, and that, if accepted, it will not be published elsewhere in the same form, in any

language, including electronically without the written consent of the copyright-holder.

**Categories of submissions** 

• Paper (Open Access)

Research paper: Including academically valuable conclusions or facts in the original research

Technical paper: Including valuable data, phenomena or idea useful for practical usage

Research note: Short report with contents conforming to research papers or technical papers.

In this journal, research papers and technical papers are not distinguished, both are simply published as

"Paper".

### **Peer-review process**

This journal operates a single blind review process. All contributions as "paper" will be initially assessed by the editor for suitability for the journal. Papers deemed suitable are then typically sent to a minimum of two independent expert reviewers to assess the scientific quality of the paper. The Editorial board is responsible for the final decision regarding acceptance or rejection of articles, and the types of papers. The decision of the Editorial board is final.

Manuscripts for "General articles" are reviewed by the Editorial board, and acceptance or rejection of them is decided there. If the revised manuscript is not resubmitted within 3 months by the author, it is deemed to have been withdrawn.

### **Ethics in publishing**

This journal commits to a deep obligation to meet the standards of ethics through the publication process. This journal follows closely the third-party organization's principles, such as Committee on Publication Ethics (COPE, <a href="https://publicationethics.org/about/our-organisation">https://publicationethics.org/about/our-organisation</a>), World Association of Medical Editors (WAME, <a href="https://wame.org/recommendations-on-publication-ethics-policies-for-medical-journals">https://wame.org/recommendations-on-publication-ethics-policies-for-medical-journals</a>) which set the standards and provide best practices and guidance to reach the highest standard in publication ethics. In particular, some important points are also shown below.

- Authorship of the paper: Authorship should be limited to those who have made a significant contribution to the conception, design, execution, or interpretation of the reported study.
- Originality and plagiarism: The authors should ensure that they have written entirely original works, and if the authors have used the work and/or words of others, that this has been appropriately cited or quoted.
- Data access and retention: Authors may be asked to provide the raw data in connection with a paper for editorial review, and should be prepared to provide public access to such data.
- Multiple, redundant or concurrent publication: An author should not in general publish manuscripts
  describing essentially the same research in more than one journal or primary publication.
- Acknowledgement of sources: Proper acknowledgment.
- Disclosure and conflicts of interest: All submissions must include disclosure of all relationships that could be viewed as presenting a potential conflict of interest.

- Fundamental errors in published works: When an author discovers a significant error or inaccuracy in his/her own published work, it is the author's obligation to promptly notify the journal editor or publisher and cooperate with the editor to retract or correct the paper.
- Reporting standards: Authors of reports of original research should present an accurate account of the work performed as well as an objective discussion of its significance.
- Hazards and human or animal subjects: Statements of compliance are required if the work involves
  chemicals, procedures or equipment that have any unusual hazards inherent in their use, or if it involves
  the use of animal or human subjects.
- Use of patient images or case details: Studies on patients or volunteers require ethics committee approval and informed consent, which should be documented in the paper.

### Copyright

The copyrights of papers and general articles published in this journal belong to the Society of Powder Technology, Japan. In the case of reprinting sentences, figures, charts, photographs, and so on published in this journal into other works, the author must obtain the permission from to the editorial office. The source of the content copied from this journal must be specified in other works.

All proprietary rights other than copyrights, such as patent rights and the right to use all or part of the paper in later works of the authors, shall be reserved for the authors. When quoting articles of other works, they must be listed in Reference section and the source must be specified.

#### **Proofs**

Accepted manuscript is proofread twice by the corresponding author. One set of page proofs (as PDF files) is sent by e-mail to the corresponding author. The author should use this proof only for checking the typesetting, editing, completeness and correctness of the text, tables and figures. It is not allowed to insert words or phrases that can not be found in the manuscript.
